

How to make up a Christmas box

1. Get a wrapped shoebox

Each shoebox should have a lid.

2. Choose some items to put in the box

You'll need to decide who to make the box for: Male or female? How old? See labels for categories.

- First you need fun things: small toys, sweets, balls, colouring or sticker books, loom kits
- Next something practical: pens/pencils, hats, gloves, scarves
- Then something to help with hygiene: toothpaste/brush, soap, facecloth, sponge, comb

If the box looks a bit empty go and choose a few more things to fill it up. Before you go on to the next stage, ask yourself *"Would I be happy to receive this box?"*

3. Get a label for the box

Tick the box on the label for the right age/sex category.

Tick the appropriate boxes on the label to show what items have been put into the Christmas box.

4. Secure the lid to the box with two elastic bands

Put the lid on and put the elastic bands around the box to keep everything safe. Stick the label to the lid of the box.

5. Put your box with the other completed boxes
